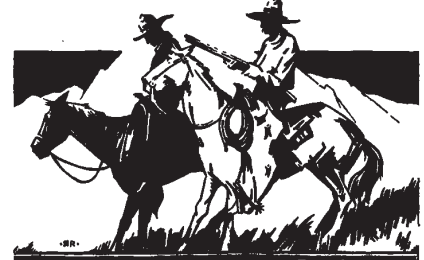
### DAVY THE OUTLAW For Bank Robbery! REWARD!
