

Pilgrim at the Fair: Quest Books

These are *Acrobat pdf* files and print out at 8 ½ by 14 inches. The booklets will measure 8 ½ x 7 inches. Because they are booklets of several pages, the right and left sides printed out will be facing other pages when they are folded and assembled.

The first section (Pages 1-4/ 21-24) is used for all;

The second sections (Pages 5-10/ 15-20) have two versions, Pre-readers and Readers

The center section (Pages 11-14) is used by all.

Covers were printed on Colored stock in three colors – a primary red, yellow and blue. Since they designate teams for the contest, there should be equal numbers of each color in each class.

There are no Scripture or Lesson worksheets for Day Three because it is the Field Sports Day – however Scriptures and Lessons on The Parable of the Wicked Tenants: Luke 20:9-18) or The Runaway Son (Luke 15:11-32) are options that can be considered. Both offer strong Gospel presentations. These could replace the Pilgrim's Journey pages 12-13, or you could move Page 11 elsewhere (to one of the songs pages?) and use that page for the Scripture text and replace page 14 with the lesson sheet.

Songs We used: *In God's Green Pastures; He Owns the Cattle, What's Gonna Make Me Long, The Wa Wa Song, Surely Goodness and Mercy, Joy is a flag flown high from the castle of my heart, It's time to praise the Lord, If any Man come after Me, I love the Father, His Banner over Me is Love, When He Cometh, You are the One, I said I wasn't gonna Tell Nobody* – many of these you may not know, but the pages have been left blank (other than clip art) for you to Cut and Paste in the songs you will use – I put them in two columns on each page. Clip art is on the pages already, try to fit the songs around them or move the art.

We used rubber stamps in the boxes on the various lesson pages – one for each day, stickers can be used too. These are earned as you tabulate each day's points for the contest. A system should be worked out for awarding these and scoring the points for each team.

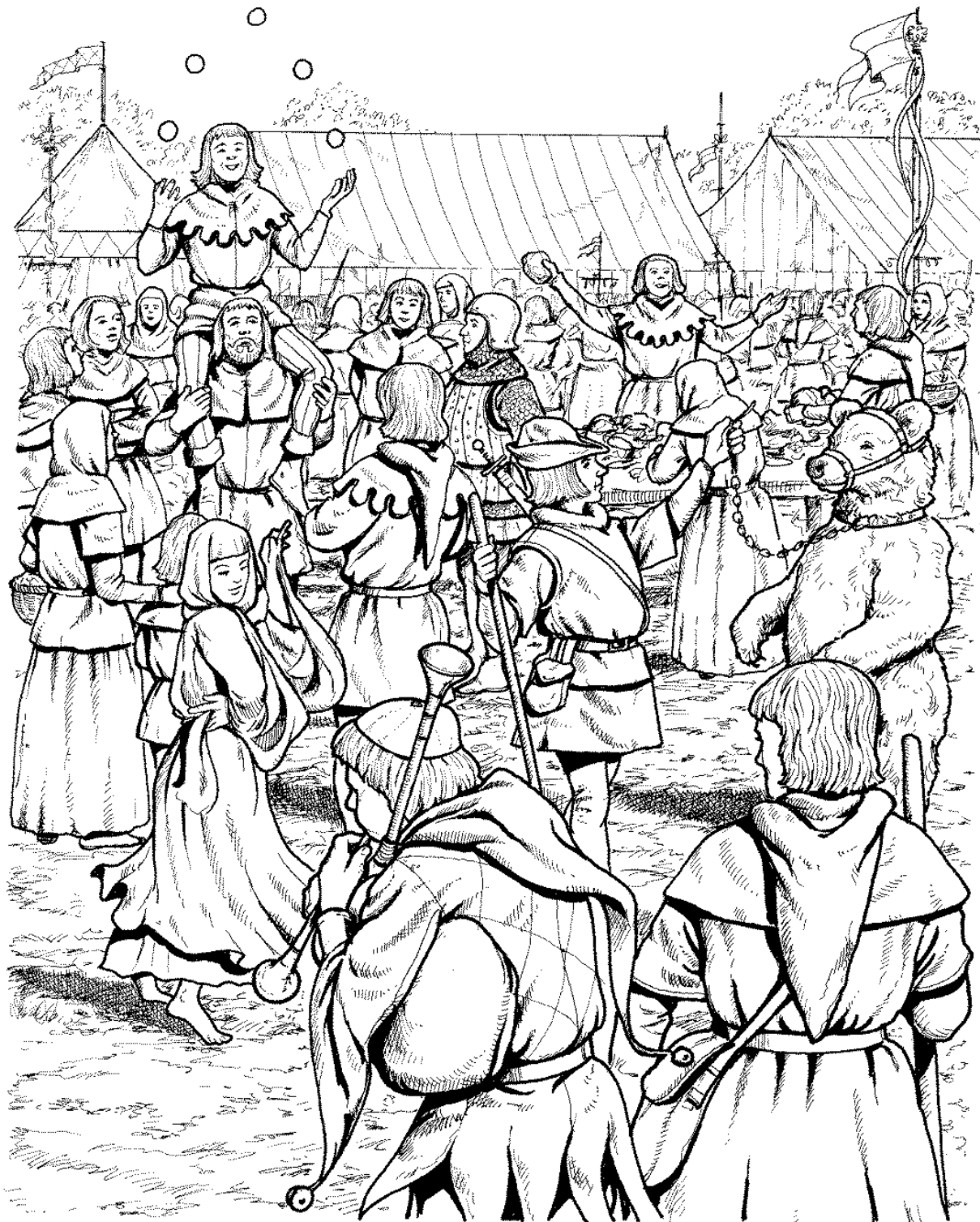

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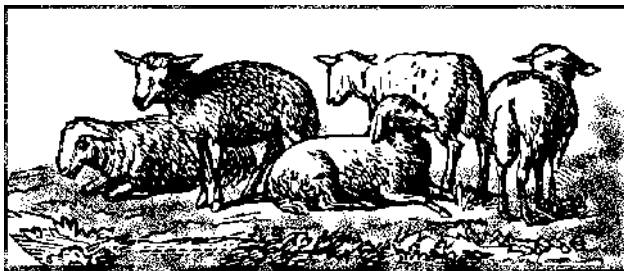

The Story of the Lost Sheep

Luke 15:1-10



Now the tax collectors and "sinners" were all gathering around to hear him. But the Pharisees and the teachers of the law muttered, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them."

Then Jesus told them this parable: "Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Does he not leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.' I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent."

"Or suppose a woman has ten silver and loses one. Does she not light a lamp, sweep the house and search carefully until she finds it? And when she finds it, she calls her friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost coin.' In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents."

Were you worried that it would never be found?
And then have you found it!
Do you remember how happy you were then?
The Bible tells us we are like lost sheep – Jesus is looking for us!
